The following Virtual Learning Playbook will provide information regarding how school will operate during the 2020-2021 school year. I know that you have been waiting for some specific instructions on how your students will begin the school year. I appreciate your patience and hope this letter answers your questions and provides resources to successfully navigate Distance Learning.

- □ Students generally will spend 2.5 to 3 hours a day in live, interactive sessions with teachers and classmates and 1 to 1.5 hours a day completing self-paced activities.
- Teachers and staff will have clearly defined roles and expectations and will regularly check on students.

8:45-11:35	Classroom instruction Each classroom teacher will provide you a detailed educational schedule which will include the times the core subjects will be taught as well as special areas such as art, music, Spenish, physical education, and SEL. Synchronous and Asynchronous learning will occur.		
11:36-1:00	Lunch Time for everyone • During this lunch time, instruction will pause so that all students and staff can eat lunch and prepare for the afternoon lessons.		
1:00-3:00	Clearcom Instruction Each classroom teacher will provide you a detailed educational schedule which will include the times core subjects will be taught, special areas such as art, music, Spanish, physical education, and SEL. Students will be required to sign back into their google classroom after lunch. Closing of the day and check-ins. Synchronous and Asynchronous learning will occur.		

The school day will begin at 8:45 a.m. and conclude at 3:00 p.m., with 80 minutes for lunch and recess from 11:35 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. Each week, the teacher will provide scheduled learning opportunities for each of their classes via Google Classroom. The schedule will be consistent from week to week. Below is the framework that will be used to design daily/weekly instruction.

Expectations for Virtual Learning

There are important distinctions between the remote learning that occurred in the spring and the Virtual Learning Experience that is planned for the 2020-2021 school year. Some of the exciting features of the Virtual Learning Experience includes a daily morning meeting and engaging in activities that promote empathy and an understanding for how each student's personal attributes matter to and impacts those around them.

We will be utilizing **Google Classroom**, which will serve as a virtual classroom or hub, holding all class assignments, activities, quizzes, tests, and more. Students and teachers can also communicate with each other via Google Classroom and other district approved platforms. We hope that these instructional tools will offer teachers, students and parents a streamlined approach to teaching and learning this fall.

Students will receive feedback on their work, and teachers will monitor and track students' engagement.

Teachers and/or the school principal will reach out with key updates and announcements, using translation and interpretation services, about the coming week. Teachers will be available during office hours to engage with students and families. By 3 p.m. Friday, September 4th all students will have received a google classroom invitation via their district email address.

Student & Family Expectations

This school year will present unique challenges to students, parents, and teachers. We do not expect parents to become educators. We will be hosting a series of workshops over the next few weeks to provide strategies for parents and caregivers to help to maximize students' productivity in the virtual learning environment such as creating a daily routine so your student always knows when it will be time to focus on learning. Please be sure to check the school website frequently for updates.
