











# Township of Union Public Schools - Guidelines for Keeping Children Home from School

I have a FEVER		Temperature 100F and above, sore throat, earache, diarrhea, vomiting or not feeling well.
I have DIARRHEA		Two or more loose/watery bowel movements within 24 hours.
I am VOMITING		Vomiting Within 24 hours.
I have an eye infection or drainage, PINK EYE		Itchy, swollen eye lids, pink/red eye with whitish or greenish drainage.
I have a RASH		Itchy, elevated and draining rash with or without fever.
I have a RUNNY NOSE, COUGHING & WHEEZING		Congested with thick greenish drainage or wheezing. Earache.
I have a SORE THROAT		With fever or swollen glands.
I have head LICE OR NITS		Itchy scalp, lice and nits
I have been diagnosed with STREP THROAT		Red/sore throat with patches on tonsils. Swollen glands, fever, Rash and/or stomachache
I HAVE BEEN IN THE HOSPITAL		Hospital or emergency room visit.
<b>To return to school, students need/have to be...</b>		
Fever -free for 24 hours without fever reducing meds such as Tylenol, Motrin, and Advil, etc.	Free from diarrhea for 24 hours without medication.	Free from vomiting for 24 hours without medication
No drainage from eyes and have completed 24 hours of treatment.	Rash free or evaluated by MD before sending back to school.	Fever- free, nasal drainage resolved or lessen and color should be clear.
Fever -free without fever-reducing medications for 24 hours such as Tylenol, Motrin, and Advil, etc.	To be brought to school nurse's office by parent or guardian. Nits free	Fever -free without fever-reducing medications such as Tylenol, Motrin, and Advil, etc. for 24 hours.
A copy of discharge instruction or medical clearance from MD; including any physical restrictions /activities.
